

Instruction for reprocessing of manually operated dispenser systems:

ingo-man[®] classic ingo-man[®] plus

Based on recommendations of the Commission for Hospital Hygiene and Infection Prevention at the Robert-Koch-Institute.¹



A complete setup of the dispenser system requires several steps to be followed. Those steps, described in detail in the subsequent document, are structured as follows:

- Preparative measures and dispenser reassembly
- Cleaning measures
- Disinfection measures and dispenser reassembly
- Frequency of reprocessing and additional measures

 For protection gloves should always be worn when cleaning and disinfecting any dispenser and pump – in accordance with the indication "contact with potentially infectious materials".

• Remove the bottle from the dispenser.


• Front removal of pump – please note: push the corresponding unlock button for the removal.

• Remove the dispenser housing from back plate by pushing the tab on the back plate.











• Wipe the pump tube with a clean and disposable paper towel to remove potential product residuals.

- Clean the pump by applying hot water and with a clean disposable wipe with special focus on outlet of pump – for this cleaning step: you can remove the silicone membrane. Dry the pump by using a disposable paper towel.
- For soap dispensers: Rinse the pump with hot water.

• Clean the housing under running hot water – remove any soilings with a brush.

• Complete drying of housing by using a disposable paper towel.













• Wipe disinfection of back plate by applying a suitable surface disinfectant.

• Wipe disinfection of pump by applying a suitable surface disinfectant.

• Wipe disinfection of dispenser housing by applying a suitable surface disinfectant.

• Affix the dispenser housing on back plate.














• Insert a new bottle of alcohol-based hand rub.

• Pushing the lever of the dispenser several times before usage.

• Alternatively: dispensers for dosing soaps can be equipped with a new bottle of soap now. Please note: Pump the lever several times to get soap.















Frequency of reprocessing

• The Robert Koch-Institute recommends: The scope and frequency of checks and the reprocessing of dispensers should be specified in the internal hygiene plan.²

Additional measures:

• Daily wipe disinfection of the lever.



• Visible soilings on the outlet should be removed by performing a wipe disinfection.

• Visible soilings on the dispenser housing should be removed by performing a wipe disinfection.
